

Questions for Consideration—Lesson 20—Matthew 7:13-14—Heaven is for Real
and Hell is For Real!

1. (a) As you read Matthew 7:13 and 14 write down as many contrasts as you find.
(b) Which gate are you going to enter?
2. Memorize Matthew 7:13, 14.
3. (a) As you read Psalm 1 and Psalm 73, what things stand out to you as similar to Mathew 7:13, 14? (b) How does the Psalmist describe each of the ways of the godly and the ungodly? (c) How does the Psalmist describe each of their destinations?
4. (a) Read Matthew 25:31-46. What are the two destinations that Christ mentions in this passage? (b) What determines one's destination according to this text? (c) In what ways is this passage similar to what we have studied in the Sermon on the Mount? (d) Why do you think some say there is more than two destinations, heaven or hell?
5. (a) According to Romans 8:18; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Philippians 3:20,21; Revelation 21:3,4, 27 and Revelation 22:3-5, what awaits those who go through the narrow gate? (b) According to Daniel 12:2; Matthew 18:8; Matthew 25:41,46; 2 Thessalonians 1:9 and Revelation 20:10 what awaits those who go through the wide gate? (c) Why do you think few travel the narrow way while many travel the broad way?
6. (a) As you prayerfully reflect on this lesson, are you sure of which road you are traveling down? (b) Is there anyone you know who professes to be going down the narrow road, but you fear is going down the wide road instead? (c) Will you lovingly share with them the danger they are in?
7. Write a request for yourself or for someone else (be discreet please) which pertains to this lesson.
