

Questions for Consideration—*With the Master Remembering Precious Truths*  
Lesson 4—Are We Paying Attention to the Inspired Word of God?—2 Peter 1:19-21

1. Read 2 Peter 1:19-21 and make note of any observations you see regarding the Scriptures. Summarize 2 Peter 1 in three sentences.
2. Memorize 2 Peter 1:19-21 (These verses are so important!)
3. (a) In what ways is the written Word a light that shines in a dark place according to Psalm 19:8; 119:105; 119:130; Proverbs 6:23? (b) In what ways is the written Word a light to you?
4. (a) Peter writes that holy men of old spoke as the Holy Spirit moved them. Who were some of these holy men of old according to the following verses and what are some of the things God told them? (*you may have to read a few more verses than what are listed.*) See Numbers 16:28; 2 Samuel 23:1,2; Jeremiah 30:1-3; Ezekiel 35:1,2; Hosea 1:1,2; Joel 1:1; Haggai 2:1,2. (b) Why isn't God speaking today so that men can write more of His Words? (*Prove your answer biblically*)
5. (a) In what ways can we, as God's daughter's take heed to the written Word of God? (b) In what way(s) do you need to take better heed to God's Word?
6. (a) What are the dangers of misinterpreting the Bible? (b) Why is it essential that we do in-depth Bible study? (c) What role do you think the Holy Spirit plays in our study of God's Word?
7. My friend, oh how we need to pay attention to the Word of God. What needs to be rooted out of your busy life so that you can pay better attention to the Word? Please write your need in the form of a prayer request.
