

Questions for Consideration—*With the Master Remembering Precious Truths*  
Lesson 6—Some Sobering Examples and Striking Encouragements—2 Peter 2:4-9

1. Read 2 Peter 2:4-9 and answer the following questions. (a) Who are the people and the places mentioned in these verses? (b) What facts are mentioned about these people and places? (c) What might be some of the reasons Peter writes about these people and places in this epistle?
2. Memorize 2 Peter 2:9.
3. Read Genesis 19 and answer the following questions. (a) What evil was going on that caused God to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah? (b) What other evil was going on in Sodom and Gomorrah according to Ezekiel 16:48-50? (c) What things do you notice about Lot? (d) Why do you think Peter refers to him as being just? (For some hints, read Genesis 18:22-33 also).
4. Read Genesis 6 and answer the following questions. (a) What things were going on in Noah's day that were evil? (b) What were God's responses to this evil? (c) What was Noah's response to what God asked Him to do? (d) Do you think you would respond as Noah did? Why or why not?
5. (a) Peter mentions in 2 Peter 2:4 that there were angels who sinned. What might have been their sin according to Isaiah 14:12-15? (b) What else do you learn about these sinning angels from Revelation 12? (c) What warnings are there for us when we consider this sobering fact that angels in heaven sinned against their Creator?
6. (a) When we consider the three examples Peter gives in 2 Peter 2:4-8, what should be our response? (b) How does Romans 2:5-11 compare with what Peter writes in 2 Peter 2:9? (c) How do we make sure we are not among the ungodly who will be destroyed?
7. (a) What should be our reaction when we see and hear of wickedness in our world? (b) How can we remain godly in this age of evil? (c) Since God will destroy all the ungodly, what should be our responsibility to those without Christ according to 2 Corinthians 5:11?
8. After careful examination of this study and your own heart, what would be your request for yourself? Please write it down to share with your group.
