Lesson 12 — Final Exhortation and Final Encouragement to Remember — 2 Peter 3:17-18

1. Read 2 Peter, chapter three, and summarize it in three sentences.

2. Memorize either 2 Peter 3:17 or 18 or both!

3. (a) Peter ends this epistle with a praise that God would get the glory. As you reflect on the epistle of 2 Peter, in what ways can we give glory to God? Please list at least five ways from this epistle. (b) Do you endeavor to glorify God? (*Personal question*) (c) What are some ways in which we as God's daughters can bring our Lord glory?

4. (a) Name at least one individual in Scripture who was led away by error, either moral or doctrinal. What do you learn from this individual? (b) What should we be doing to avoid this terrible tragedy?

5. (a) When you look back over 2 Peter and consider all the precious truths Peter has written, which one stands out as most precious to you and why? (b) As we consider a final exhortation and a final encouragement in Peter's closing remarks: 1) What has been the most encouraging portion of 2 Peter to you? 2) And what has been the most sobering exhortation to you?

6. (a) Look back at your first lesson's homework. What did you hope to gain from this study according to your answer to question 7? (b) Did you gain that for which you hoped? If so, thank God for it.

7. Write a praise to the Lord based on your answer to question 5a.
