

Questions to Consider—With the Master in Heavenly Places—Lesson 1—Ephesians 1:1, 2



1. Read the Epistle to the Ephesians and list ten key words or phrases that you think Paul gives importance to. Also, list any reasons for their importance.
2. Memorize Ephesians 1:1.
3. What are some facts you already know about the Epistle to the Ephesians?
4. (a) Read over Acts chapter 19 and 20 and list any further facts you glean about the city of Ephesus and the Ephesians. (b) How would these facts influence Paul's letter to them?
5. What are the similarities in Paul's opening remarks in Ephesians 1:1, 2 and his closing remarks in Ephesians 6:23, 24?
6. Paul addresses the believers at Ephesus as "saints" and "faithful in Christ Jesus." How would you describe the believers in your church if you were addressing them in a letter?
7. What do you personally hope to gain from this study in Ephesians? Why not pause right now and ask the Lord to help you with the desire of your heart?
8. Have you experienced the grace of God that Paul is speaks of in Ephesians 1:2? Do you have a living relationship with God our Father and His Son Jesus Christ? If so, write a praise of thanksgiving, to be shared with your group, for what this amazing grace means in your life!
