



**Questions to Consider—With the Master in Heavenly Places—  
Lesson 3—Ephesians 1:10-14 (Part 2)—The Believer’s Blessings in  
Christ!**

1. (a) Read Ephesians 1:10-14 and list all the blessings that you see for the believer. (b) Who is the giver of these blessings? (c) Why are we given these blessings?
2. Memorize Ephesians 1: 13, 14.
3. As you read over Ephesians 1:3-14, write down the places and the context in which Paul mentions that something is for God’s glory, His pleasure or His grace. What things do you observe? What does this tell you about God? About His glory? His pleasure? His grace?
4. Paul says in Ephesians 1: 12 that there were some who first trusted in Christ, and then in verse 13 he indicates that there was another group who trusted in Christ. Read over Acts chapters 10 and 11 to see another account in which there were some who first trusted in Christ and then how it was that there was a second group of people who trusted in Christ. Write down any observations or truths from Acts that help you to better understand what Paul is saying in Ephesians 1:13, 14.
5. How could you use verses 10-14, especially verse 11, to encourage someone (or yourself) is going through troubling times?
6. Which blessing from Ephesians 1:10-14 is especially meaningful to you and why?
7. Is there someone you are praying for who has not yet trusted in Christ and been sealed with Holy Spirit of Promise? Please write a prayer request for their salvation.
