

**Questions to Consider—With the Master in Heavenly Places—Lesson 7—Ephesians 2:19-22—Citizens of the Household of God!**



1. Read Ephesians 2:19-22 and answer the following questions. (a) What terms are used to describe Christ? (b) What terms are used to describe His children? (c) Why do you think Christ is described as the chief cornerstone?
2. Memorize Ephesians 2:20.
3. (a) In Ephesians 2:20 Paul says that Jesus Christ is the chief cornerstone. What else is He called, in Isaiah 28:16 and 1 Peter 2:7, 8? (b) What has been the response to the Chief Cornerstone throughout the ages? See Psalm 118:22; Matthew 21:42; Acts 4:11, 12; 1 Peter 2:7, 8. (c) In what ways do you see Christ, the chief cornerstone, being rejected in our day? (d) In what ways do you see Him being treated as precious in our day? (e) Is He precious to you?
4. (a) What are some of the future privileges of those who are citizens of the household of God, according to Galatians 3:26-29, Philippians 3:20, 21; Revelation 20, 21 and 22. (b) Which of these privileges do you look forward to the most?
5. After reading over these verses in chapter 2, what do you think should be our attitude towards those in God's kingdom who differ from us in race, ethnicity, culture or social status?
6. What does it mean to you personally that you are a fellow citizen with the saints and a member of the household of God?
7. Write a prayer of thanksgiving to the Father for calling you to be a daughter in His house.
