



**Questions to Consider—With the Master in Heavenly Places—  
Lesson 12—Ephesians 4:17-24—Off With the Old Man—On With  
the New Man!**

1. (a) What are some of the ways we used to walk, according to what Paul says in Ephesians 4:17-24? (b) Also, what do Ephesians 2:1-3, 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, Galatians 5:19-21, Colossians 3:5-9 and 1 Peter 4:1-3 say about the old man? (c) What does the walk of the new man look like according to Romans 13:12-14, Ephesians 4:17-24 and Colossians 3:10-4:1 (d) What are some other passages that come to your mind regarding the characteristic of the old man and the characteristic of the new man?

2. Memorize Ephesians 4:23.

3. (a) Compare Romans 1:18-32 and Ephesians 4:17-24. What things does Paul write in these passages that are similar regarding mankind in their unredeemed state? (b) Why do you think Scripture is replete with descriptions of man in his lost condition?

4. (a) Paul mentions in Ephesians 4:19 that one of the deeds of an unredeemed man is all uncleanness with greediness. What is the danger of this deed of the flesh, greediness, according to Ecclesiastes 5; Luke 12:15; and 1 Timothy 6:6-10? (b) What should we be pursuing instead, according to 1 Timothy 6:11, 12? (c) How do you see this sin manifested in our world today? (d) How do you personally fight the sin of greed in your own life?

5. How would you use Ephesians 4:17-24 to help someone who claims they know Christ but whose life is characterized by the old man?

6. (a) What are some practical ways that you have found to be helpful in putting off the old man and putting on the new man? (b) How do you practically renew your mind, as Paul says in Ephesians 4:23?
